## MORE POPULAR SPOTS

**IMAGINE CHILDREN'S MUSEUM.** The perfect place to entertain little ones on a rainy day. 1502 Wall St. **THE NEW MEXICANS.** The enclosed patio is an al fresco escape for rainy summer days. 1416 Hewitt Ave. **THE EVERETT YMCA.** Grab a day pass and take a class or hit the pool. 4730 Colby Ave. **THE INDEPENDENT BEER BAR.** Play shuffleboard or a board game while sampling beer and wine from around the Pacific Northwest. 1801 Hewitt Ave. **ZAB THAI.** Hands down some of the best Thai food around. 11108 Evergreen Way.

We're not going to lie: it rains here. The gray, the dark, the clouds—it's all part of the Pacific Northwest experience, and we love it because it makes everything green. Here are a few of the ways we enjoy the rainy days in Everett.

Take a trip to **1. FUNKO HQ** to get a blast of pop culture. Visit their themed showroom and snap a pic with Chewbacca or hang at Hogwarts. Take a vinyl Pop! figurine home with you and put it on your desk. Maybe it'll drive the rainy blues away.

Visit the **2. DOWNTOWN BANYA SPA**, which has a sauna built by a third-generation stove maker. Banya is also a bistro and the only place in town where you can hit steam baths and order herring and onions for dinner.

Head to **3. EVERGREEN LANES** (5111 Claremont Way), a vintage bowling alley. There's a restaurant with a full bar. Eat pizza and play arcade games.

There's nothing like a cozy coffee shop on a rainy day. **4. NARRATIVE COFFEE** offers craft coffee, an expert staff, and a delicious breakfast and lunch menu. It's a perfect place to wait out a rainstorm on a gray afternoon.

Climbing indoors is an excellent workout. At the **5. SUMMIT EVERETT CLIMBING GYM** you can rent shoes and spend a day scrambling skyward. Never climbed before? Trained and qualified staff will show you the ropes (literally). The gym offers showers and a changing area.

Bring the heat at **6. RED CHILLY**. They serve up some of the best Indian and Mediterranean cuisine in downtown. Try the butter chicken with garlic naan.
